Take cash flow snapshots to capture and preserve the state of a cash flow at specific points in time. This enables teams to compare how financial projections or actuals change over the course of a project and supports historical record-keeping, auditing, and variance analysis.

Cost Breakdown Structure (CBS) Integration

Track and manage cash flow at each CBS level for granular financial monitoring. Aggregate data across your cost structure for a unified portfolio view, project-by-project comparisons, and valuable insights.

Schedule-Driven Cash Flow Management
